NOTICE OF A CROWN COURT ORDER REQUIRING A LOCAL HIGHWAY AUTHORITY TO TAKE STEPS FOR SECURING THE REMOVAL OF AN OBSTRUCTION

OBSTRUCTION OF PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY Y 24/10, BARCROFT LANE, SOUTH PETHERTON BY GATES, PILLAR AND UPLIGHTER.

Notice is hereby given that an order has been made by **Taunton Crown Court** on **9th February 2009** requiring **Somerset County Council** to take the steps set out in the Schedule below for securing the removal of the above obstructions.

The order takes effect on **2nd March 2009**. However, if an appeal in respect of the order is brought before that date, the order will not take effect until the final determination or withdrawal of the appeal.

Right to Appeal. Any person aggrieved by this order, and any other person responsible for the obstruction, may appeal to the Crown Court not later than 21 days after the date on which the order was made. The Crown Court has power to extend this period.

SCHEDULE

- 1) SCC remove the central pillar and corresponding uplighter and all gates and the electronic opening and closing mechanism.
- 2) SCC install a fingerpost to the west of the gateway indicating the route of Y24/10.
